

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### 3rd International Scientific Conference "The Multidimensionality of Cybersecurity. New Dimensions of Digital Crime: Law, Technology, Society"

Warsaw, 16–17 April 2026

#### 1. General provisions

1.1. The 3rd International Scientific Conference "The Multidimensionality of Cybersecurity. New Dimensions of Digital Crime: Law, Technology, Society", hereinafter referred to as the "Conference", will be held on 16–17 April 2026 at the headquarters of the Helena Chodkowska University of Technology and Economics (ul. Jutrzenki 135, Warsaw).

## 2. Rules for participation and cancellation of participation

2.1. Conference participants include research and teaching staff, as well as practitioners interested in the multidimensional nature of cybersecurity and hate speech.

2.2. To successfully register for the Conference (active and passive participation in person and online), you must complete the registration form available on the conference website by 27 March 2026 and pay the fee in the amount and by the date specified in point 2.4.

2.3. The Organiser shall not be liable for any damage resulting from the entry of incorrect data in the registration form by the Registrant. The Organiser undertakes to keep confidential all information (data) obtained from the registrant, with the exception of data intended for inclusion in the conference catalogue and published in the post-conference publication.

2.4. The fee referred to in section 2.2. is:

- PLN 650 - the fee covers on-site participation in the conference - active or passive, meals, including participation in the gala dinner; however, it does not cover the costs of the post-conference publication, accommodation and travel;
- PLN 250 - the fee covers *online* participation in the conference - active or passive, without meals and without participation in the gala dinner; the fee does not cover the costs of the post-conference publication,
- PLN 600 – cost of publication of a paper in a peer-reviewed post-conference publication in the case of passive or active participation in the conference, both in-person and *online*;

The fee should be transferred to the bank account of Pekao SA 08 1240 6292 1111 0010 3988 3329, no later than 27 March 2026. The transfer title should include: *III International Scientific Conference "Multidimensionality of cybersecurity. New dimensions of digital crime: law, technology, society"*, the name and surname of the person to whom the transfer relates, and the details of the institution represented.

2.5. The organiser may exempt a person from paying the conference fee referred to in point 2.4.

2.5. After registration and payment of the fee, a confirmation email will be sent confirming acceptance of the registration. If you do not receive such confirmation, please contact the Conference organiser (conference.cybersecurity@uth.edu.pl).

2.7. Failure to pay the fee for participation in the Conference within the time limit specified by the Organiser in these regulations entitles the Organiser to cancel the registration without incurring any liability for damages.

2.8. At the individual request of a Conference Participant, the Organiser shall issue a VAT invoice for participation in the Conference.

2.9. A Conference Participant may withdraw from participation in the Conference. A statement of withdrawal from participation in the Conference should be made in writing and sent to the email address [conference.cybersecurity@uth.edu.pl](mailto:conference.cybersecurity@uth.edu.pl). In the event of withdrawal from participation in the Conference, made no later than 21 days before the date of the planned conference, the Participant is entitled to a refund of the entire amount paid.

However, if the cancellation occurs at a later date, the Participant is entitled to a refund of fifty percent of the amount paid.

2.9. The Organiser reserves the right to change the date of the conference or cancel it in circumstances beyond its control, in particular if the organisation of the event is prevented by a pandemic.

### **3. Conference agenda and rules for presentations**

3.1. The conference will take place on 16-17 April 2026 in a hybrid form. It will consist of the following plenary sessions:

- 16 April: 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.,
- 17 April: 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., 2:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m., 3:45 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

A detailed programme of the Conference will be sent to participants by email at least one week before the date of the Conference. The organisers reserve the right to change the times of the plenary sessions depending on the number of papers submitted.

3.2. Papers intended for post-conference publication should be sent by 30 April 2026 to: [conference.cybersecurity@uth.edu.pl](mailto:conference.cybersecurity@uth.edu.pl). They must not exceed 40,000 characters (including spaces and footnotes).

3.3 Papers may also be submitted by persons who did not participate, either actively or passively,

in the Conference. The condition for publication of a paper is meeting the deadline referred to in point 3.2 and the payment of a fee of PLN 800, or PLN 1,000 in the case of co-authorship, to the account number provided in point 2.4, by 27 March 2026.

3.5. Papers should be accompanied by abstracts in Polish and English (each with a length of 800 to 1,200 characters, including spaces). The text, which must meet the editorial requirements of the UTH, should be sent in electronic form.

3.6. Authors are required to submit a statement transferring copyright for the use of the submitted paper.

3.7. The selection of papers to be presented at the conference and for publication will be made by the scientific committee referred to in point 1.3. The author will be informed of the acceptance of the paper by e-mail.

#### 4. Final provisions

4.1. By submitting the application form, the participant accepts the provisions of these Regulations and agrees to comply with the rules and regulations and any other arrangements made between the participant and the organiser.

4.2. In accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 *on the protection of personal data* (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1781), the Conference Organiser shall not transfer, sell or lend the collected personal data of Participants to other persons or institutions. The personal data provided by the Participant (name and surname, address, telephone number, e-mail address) shall be used solely for conference purposes and communication between the Participant and the Conference Organisers.

4.3. In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 (GDPR), the Conference Participant consents to the processing of personal data for purposes related to registration and participation in this event. At the same time, they consent to the free use of their image and voice for the purpose of preparing documentation recording the course of the Event, as well as marketing materials related to it (photographic, audio-video coverage).
