The VI annual International Scientific and Practical Conference "Plagiarism Detection - 2021" will be held on October 20–22! The Plagiarism Detection 2021 Conference is an international platform aimed at creating an expert environment for discussing and resolving issues related to plagiarism prevention in academic and scientific circles.

Conference Objectives: formation of an expert environment for discussing pressing issues, exchanging views and developing solutions for text reuse detection in the field of education, science and publishing.

Conference participants will have an opportunity to comprehensively consider the problem of plagiarism detection in scientific and educational papers, get acquainted with the strategy of perspective development in this area, discuss a wide range of ethical, regulatory, methodological, software, technological and educational issues, learn about the best practices in the implementation and use of electronic systems for text reuse detection in educational, scientific, and publishing processes, discuss the practical use and development of digital resources in the field of education, science and culture, as well as strengthen professional connections.

This year the conference is attended, among others, by such leading international experts as:

of numerous articles on reuse by the author of his own texts, one of the founders of the "Text Recycling Research Project" on the study of issues of text reuse;

- Miguel Roig, Ph.D. Professor of Psychology St. John's University. USA, New York, author of the Ethics Writing Guidelines Avoiding Plagiarism, Self-Plagiarism, and Other Questionable Writing Practices. Through his work, it is now much easier for the US Department of Health and Human Services, medical journal editors, specialized institutes, professionals and students to identify questionable practices and develop awareness of academic ethics and ethical writing principles;
- Tomáš Foltýnek, Assistant professor, Mendel University in Brno; President of the Board, the European Network for Academic Integrity. Czech, Brno, who will cover the topic "Designing plagiarism policy: Myths and reality".
- Iren Glendinning, BSc, PhD, FBCS, CITP, CEng. Dr. of Computer Science. Coventry University, United Kingdom, one of the authors of the famous project "The Project of Academic Integrity in the Caucasus, Kazakhstan and Turkey (PAICKT)", dedicated to the analysis of the situation in academic institutions in Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Turkey and Armenia.

Main topics of the conference:

- 1. Legal basis for the use of plagiarism detection systems to verify the originality of texts of educational, qualification and scientific papers.
- 2. Methodology for the introduction and use of technical means for plagiarism detection in educational institutions of higher and secondary vocational training, research institutes, mass media, publishing sector, government agencies, and for-profit organisations.
- 3. Assessment of the legal character and correctness of text reuse, the procedure of making decisions on the compliance of submitted works with the established requirements.
- 4. Ethical and sociological problems of text reuse in the scientific research, in qualification and educational papers.
- 5. Algorithms and technologies of text reuse detection, processing and analysis.















- 6. Tools and systems of information support for the text reuse detection, electronic libraries, open access systems.
- 7. Integration of text reuse detection systems with internal data systems of organizations.

The conference will be broadcasted in 2 languages: Russian and English
